## So Far So Good

## 1. Today's Trading Playbook

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### **KEY THEMES**

As we mentioned on Sunday, this week will be eventful, but so far no surprises. Inflation has proved to be in the mid-single-digit range (as expected). This further support our view (as well as market consensus) that the CBE will hold rates when it meets later on this Thursday. We see the market maintaining its positive sentiment against this backdrop.

Now, on to the top news and analysis for the day.

## 2. TOP NEWS & ANALYSIS

### MACRO NEWS

Egypt's core inflation decreased to 0.7% in July, down from 1% in June. (Reuters)

The Egyptian Minister of Supply & Internal Trade said that the establishment of the Egyptian Commodities Exchange will be announced before the end of August. (Mubasher)

The National Telecom Regulatory Authority (NTRA) issued a regulatory framework to offer new licenses for the construction and leasing wireless communication towers within the governorates, aiming to ensure high-quality telecommunication services and create investment opportunities in a fair competitive environment. (Amwal Al-Ghad)

The Ministry of Trade & Industry is studying the establishment of a new export support program for the pharmaceutical and healthcare sector, with aims to increase the sector's exports. (Al-Ahram)

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### **CORPORATE NEWS**

Prime Holding [PRMH] announced the establishment of Prime FinTech, a platform that will be involved in setting up NBFI companies engaged in consumer finance, factoring, leasing, and cards and wallets. With a capital of EGP50mn, PRMH pursues a holistic approach in addressing the NBFI market. Meanwhile, PRMH has decreased its stake in Al Tawfeek for Financial Lease [ATLC] from 6.13% to 3.9% with the intention to sell the remaining stake at the right price and coinciding with the establishment of its NBFI arm. (Company disclosure, Hapi)

EIPICO's [PHAR] H1 2020 net profit fell 34% y/y to EGP262mn as revenues dropped 17% y/y to EGP1.5bn, and gross profit reached EGP379mn vs. EGP463mn in H1 2019. (Company disclosure)

Heliopolis Housing & Development's [HELI] plan will be approved by the Ministry of Public Enterprise early next week, according to chairman of the Holding Co. for Construction & Development. (Al-Borsa)

CI Capital Holding [CICH] and EFG Hermes Holding [HRHO have been retained as advisors for the potential acquisition of BLOM Bank Egypt by Emirates NBD. CICH is reportedly tapped by the buyer and HRHO by the seller. (Hapi, Al-Mal)

Amer Group [AMER] has secured an approval from the New Urban Communities Authority (NUCA) to reduce the area of its new urban project in New Minya City to 45 acres. (Al Mal)

Mansoura Poultry's [MPCO] Q2 2020 net profit shot up 344% y/y to EGP9.4mn as revenues surged to EGP43mn vs. EGP28mn in Q2 2019. Meanwhile, gross profit reached EGP11.3mn, up from EGP2.91mn in Q2 2019. (Company disclosure)

## **GLOBAL NEWS**

**China's auto sales in July climbed 16.4% y/y,** the fourth consecutive month of gains as the world's biggest vehicle market comes off lows hit during the country's coronavirus lockdown. (Reuters)

After two months of feeling slightly better about their odds in the labor market, Americans grew more pessimistic in July, according to a survey released Monday by the New York Federal Reserve. (Reuters)

The Federal Reserve in July bought up more bonds from blue-chip companies, including Microsoft and Coca-Cola, while it added to its positions in junk debt and made its biggest Main Street loan to a ski resort and casino in the Pocono Mountains. (CNBC)


Turkey's labor participation rate languished at 47.6% in the April-June period as a coronavirus lockdown weighed, while a ban on layoffs saw the unemployment rate edge up just slightly to 12.9%, data showed on Monday. (Reuters)

Interest rate moves by central banks across a group of 37 developing economies showed a net eight cuts in July following 16 cuts in June and May each. (Reuters)

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### 3. CHART OF THE DAY

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The Profitability-Market Share Paradox: The cement sector has been suffering lately from the relatively high costs, decrease in demand, and difficulty to export due to the product's nature which cannot be stored for long. In addition to the fragmented market in Egypt limits the producers' pricing power when competing to keep their market share. Arabian Cement [ARCC] is one of the leading cement producers in Egypt that has managed to grow its market share over the last couple of years. However, its profitability, as measured by net profit margin, has deteriorated to just 1% in 2019. Fortunately, margins improved in Q1 2020 y/y to 2.4% vs. only 0.5% a year before with the same market share of 8.4%.
