



The Neglected

1. Today's Trading Playbook

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KEY THEMES

It's the last day of the week, with almost half the month of October behind us. EGX 30 is up 3.1% mtd, while EGX 70 EWI is down 0.4% - in line with the big shift we alluded to here earlier in October. Market performance continues to be led by the financial sector (mainly banks). Meanwhile, GB Auto [AUTO] hit an 8-month high yesterday as investors re-rate its GB Capital non-banking financial business and in view of a potential recovery in car sales. Generally speaking, we believe investors should consider other EGX 30 index components that have been lagging behind, including Telecom Egypt [ETEL] and TMG Holding [TMGH]. We suggest you scan the market by taking a look at our EGX Valuation Multiples daily report to pick out those neglected stocks.

POSITIVE

TMGH, ETEL: News of another mega project for TMGH in Capital Gardens City, the new city planned near Badr City and close to the New Administrative Capital, may help re-rate the stock higher over the coming days, especially with tourism recovering slowly. The new project will add more than 50% to TMGH's current land bank. Elsewhere, we remind our clients with **ETEL** which—notwithstanding any deal concerning Vodafone Egypt [**VODE**]—is very cheap.

2. TOP NEWS & ANALYSIS

MACRO NEWS

The impact of COVID-19 on the Egyptian government's finances may not be as drastic as previously feared, according to the IMF's October 2020 Fiscal Monitor Report. (IMF)

Egypt could seal the first USD250mn tranche of USD500mn loan from the Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA) before end of year. (Al-Borsa)





Garment manufacturers have reduced their winter clothing production by up to 50% this year compared to last year, in fear of a second wave of COVID-19 in the winter season. (Masrawy)

CORPORATE NEWS

TMG Holding [TMGH] is in talks with the New Urban Communities Authority (NUCA) to develop 5,000 feddans in the new Capital Gardens City through a partnership agreement. Ongoing negotiations between the two parties will determine how the land value will be paid, be it in cash, in-kind, or a combination of both. (Al-Borsa)

The tender offers for Suez Cement [SUCE] and Tourah Portland Cement [TORA] will start today. The former will be for EGP7.5/share and run for 20 working days, while the latter will be for EGP7.18/share and run for 25 working days. (EGX: 1, 2)

Telecom Egypt [ETEL] will clear its dues to the General Authority for Roads, Bridges & Land Transport, as part of an out-of-court settlement that involves benefits for the telco. (Youm 7)

EFG Hermes Holding's [HRHO] consumer finance arm ValU signed an agreement with El-Saba Automotive to provide customers with financing facilities for car maintenance services. (Al-Mal)

Sarwa Capital [SRWA] signed an agreement with Banque Misr and Misr Capital for the issuance of an EGP2.5bn sukuk by SRWA's subsidiary. (Al-Borsa)

A.T. Lease [ATLC] said it has started factoring operations earlier this month. (Company disclosure)

Speed Medical's [SPMD] BoD approved to purchase 100% of Al-Hayah Labs for a maximum of EGP4mn, with EGP500,000 to be paid upon signing the contract and the remainder on 25 January 2021, subject to a 3-month due diligence running through 19 January 2021. The deal value is based on annualized revenues of EGP3mn (or EGP750,000 in three months), with any shortfall leading to an adjustment in the deal value. (Company disclosure)

GLOBAL NEWS

Saudi Aramco is in talks with BlackRock and other investors on a planned deal worth over USD10bn to sell a stake in its pipeline business. (Reuters)





Financial leaders from the Group of 20 major economies underscored the urgent need to bring the spread of the coronavirus pandemic under control and vowed to "do whatever it takes" to support the global economy and financial stability. (Reuters)

After reaching its trough in May 2020, world trade volume continued restoring some of its lost ground in July, standing at 116.6 (-6.2% ytd) (base year 2010 = 100). World trade was down as much as 17% ytd level in May before starting to recover in June when it was down 11% ytd.
