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Urea Frenzy

1. Today's Trading Playbook

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KEY THEMES

Coal prices continued to soar globally, especially inside China, due to rebounding demand for power sources. On the other hand, natural gas prices continued to surge, as traders assess the situation in Europe of weak natural gas supplies.

Higher thermal coal and natural gas prices are usually good for urea prices, as both commodities are primarily used to produce urea, either inside or outside China. This should bode well for nitrogen Fertilizers' stocks in Egypt, especially Abu Qir Fertilizers [ABUK] and MOPCO [MFPC] as the medium-term outlook for urea prices gets solidified.

2. Top News & Analysis

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MACRO NEWS

A small group of MPs will draft legislation aiming to postpone for another year the reintroduction of capital gains tax on EGX transactions, which is slated for January 2022. (Masrawy)

Italian tourists are now allowed to travel to Sharm El-Sheikh and Marsa Alam without needing to quarantine at either end of their trip. The Italian health ministry said as it launched an experimental "COVID-free tourist corridors" policy. (Reuters)

Saudi Arabia's cabinet approved on Tuesday the license for the National Bank of Egypt (NBE) to open a branch in the kingdom. (Reuters)





CORPORATE NEWS

Pioneers Holding [PIOH] submitted a request to suspend trading on its stock for three sessions starting 5 October, as it is about to demerge into three companies: (1) Pioneers Holding for Financial Investments, (2) Pioneers Properties, and (3) Gadwa for Industrial Development. (Company disclosure)

EFG Hermes Holding [HRHO] was appointed by A.U.F (the parent company of Abu Auf), a company specializing in healthy food products and nuts, to float a 49% stake of the company on EGX by Q2 2022. (Enterprise)

Canal Shipping Agencies [CSAG] sees revenues reaching EGP60mn in 2021/22, up from the EGP50mn expected for 2020/21. Also, as per its 2021/22 budget, net income is projected to hit EGP154.5mn, down from the EGP196mn targeted for the year earlier. That was as a result from a pressured by an expected decrease in investment income from **Port Said Container & Cargo Co.** and **Damietta Container & Cargo Holding Co.** (Company disclosure)

Upper Egypt Flour Mills [UEFM] reported its audited consolidated financial results for FY21, where net profit edged up to EGP147.1mn (+2.4% y/y) from EGP143.7mn in FY20. Meanwhile, revenues reached EGP1,178mn (-0.6% y/y), and gross margin widened to 20.7% (+55.4 bps y/y). (Company disclosure)

GLOBAL NEWS

The East Asia and Pacific region's recovery has been undermined by the spread of the COVID-19 Delta variant, which would likely slow economic growth and increase inequality in the region, the World Bank said on Monday. (Reuters)

Investors made a hasty exit from exchange-traded emerging-market bond funds last week, as China's wobble over the Evergrande crisis and expectations for a Fed taper later this year led investors to withdraw from riskier debt. Investors withdrew almost USD83bn from EM debt ETFs last week. (Bloomberg)

U.S. consumer confidence fell to a seven-month low in September as a relentless rise in COVID-19 cases deepened concerns about the economy's near-term prospects, fitting in with expectations for a slowdown in growth in the third quarter. (Reuters)

A shortfall in global energy supplies is spilling into crude markets and could add momentum to this year's rally in oil prices, investors say. (WSJ)



U.S. Treasury 2- and 5-year yields have risen to their highest levels since March 2020, owing to recent hawkish Fed prospects and ongoing negotiations in the U.S. Congress to raise the federal debt limit and avoid crippling debt. Treasuries are also facing headwinds from an escalating power crunch in China and across Europe that is driving global energy prices significantly higher.
