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Another Volatile Morning in Global Markets

1. Today's Trading Playbook

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KEY THEMES

Global markets kicked off the week on a very jittery notion, affected by the surging cases of Omicron in Europe and the United States, which spooked investor worries. Investors are afraid that re-imposing restrictions on economic activity in major regions is a strong possibility. U.S. equity futures slipped notably in early Monday trading. Meanwhile, Brent oil prices are now trading near USD71/bbl, down 3-4% as the market tries to assess any potential lower demand for fuel products. Other equity markets, including Asian shares, were down for pretty much the same reason. We mentioned here before late November that volatility in global markets is to be expected as investors around the globe slowly get a grasp of the expected impact from the new COVID-19 variant. We note that since then readings of the S&P500 Volatility Index [VIX] have been scoring their highest levels in almost eleven months.

2. TOP NEWS & ANALYSIS

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MACRO NEWS

Suez Canal revenues reached USD6bn from the beginning of the year until mid-December. (Economy Plus)

Saudi electronics retailer "Extra" plans to spend EGP1bn to open in Egypt, marking the company's first expansion outside the GCC region. (<u>CNBC Arabia</u>)

CORPORATE NEWS

Elsewedy Electric's [SWDY] subsidiary Rowad Modern Engineering (51% owned by SWDY) signed two contracts. The first contract is with Emaar Misr for Development [**EMFD**] to construct Mividia Office Park project for a total of EGP996mn. Meanwhile, the second contract is with New Giza to construct New Giza Hospital, with a total project value of EGP602mn. (Company disclosures: 1, 2)





Cleopatra Hospital Group's [CLHO] board of directors has approved a bid from CI Capital Holding [CICH] to acquire up to 26.2% of CLHO's shares. (Company disclosure)

Eastern Company [EAST] decided to halt production at "Muharram Bek" cigarette factory for the time being until further notice due to high levels of inventory. (Company disclosure)

Three major tobacco companies have reportedly chosen not to bid for a license to manufacture cigarettes. International tobacco producers, namely JTI-Nakhla Tobacco, British American Tobacco Egypt, and Al Mansour International Distribution Company will not be taking part in the renewed tender from the Industrial Development Authority (IDA). (Akhbar-Elyom)

GLOBAL NEWS

Russia, the world's largest wheat exporter, is considering imposing higher export tariffs if wheat prices reach USD375/ton, with a bigger hike proposed if prices reach USD400/ton. (Regulation Russia)

The U.S. dollar hovered near its highest point in seventeen months against major peers on Monday after Federal Reserve officials signaled a first pandemic-era interest rate increase could come as early as March. (Reuters)

Oil prices slumped by more than 2% on Monday as surging cases of Omicron, COVID-19 variant, in Europe and the United States stoked investor worries that new restrictions on businesses to combat its spread may hit fuel demand. (Reuters)


