2. TOP NEWS & ANALYSIS

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MACRO NEWS

Urban headline inflation increased to 5.9% in December, slightly lower than our expectation of 6.1%. (CAPMAS)

Morocco and Egypt have reached an agreement to exempt Renault cars produced in Tangiers from import fees. Following negotiations, the imported cars will be exempt from all customs duties as per the Agadir agreement. (Hespress)

The Saudi Sovereign Fund seeks to cooperate with the Sovereign Fund of Egypt in implementing projects to produce renewable energy, green hydrogen and water desalination. (Economy Plus)





CORPORATE NEWS

Porto Holding Group's [PORT] EGM approved yesterday the change in the company's name to be known as Arab Developers Holding. (Company disclosure)

GB Auto's [AUTO] investment MNT-Halan is looking to expand regionally this year, to enter new markets. Meanwhile, MNT is currently studying the possibility of expanding its service offerings in Egypt to include card financing and supply chain in the short term. (Enterprise)

Alexandria Pharmaceuticals' [AXPH] 5M 2021/22 bottom line came in at EGP45.4mn (-30% y/y) despite a 1.4% annual growth in revenues to EGP475.4mn. (Mubasher)

The Alta Semper Capital direct investment fund intends to sell about 80% of its stake in Macro Group Pharmaceuticals (Macro Capital) [MCRO] through the planned offering of 45.8% of MCRO's total shares on EGX. (Al-Mal)

SODIC [OCDI] has signed an agreement with Finnish British Consortium for Investment (FBC) and Finnish Global Education Solutions (FGES) to set up a Finnish-British school in its SODIC East project. The school is expected to begin operating in 2023. (Enterprise)

GLOBAL NEWS

Emerging economies must prepare for U.S. interest rate hikes, the International Monetary Fund said, warning that faster-than-expected Federal Reserve moves could rattle financial markets and trigger capital outflows and currency depreciation abroad. (Reuters)

Oil prices edged up on Monday as supply disruptions in Kazakhstan and Libya offset worries stemming from the rapid global rise in Omicron infections. (Reuters)


The bond market could again set the course for the week ahead, after rapidly rising interest rates gave stocks a choppy start to the new year. (<u>CNBC</u>)

Egypt's total vehicle sold units increased 2.1% y/y during November 2021. Bus sales recorded the highest increase of 45.4% y/y, while passenger cars witnessed a decrease of about 3.9% y/y to c.19,700 cars in November 2021.
