Oil Rallies on Geopolitical Tension

KEY THEMES

Oil prices continued to trend upward in early Tuesday trading on the back of concerns over potential supply disruptions. Such concerns were reinforced after Yemen's Houthi group attacked the United Arab Emirates through a drone attack. The build-up of geopolitical tensions has driven Brent oil prices to its best levels since October 2014, trading above the USD87/bbl.

Here at home, after almost three weeks of action in 2022, both of the EGX30 and EGX70 EWI are mildly down, with the ytd performance for both indices at 0.75%, and 0.28% respectively. Despite us being down so far in January, we note that January was historically a good month for the EGX30. Since 2005, the index monthly close in January came 65% (11 times) in the positive territory, whereas 35% (6 times) its monthly close came in red. Moreover, the index average monthly return in January during such period is 4.7%. In 65% of the time, when the index scores a positive monthly close, the average monthly return is 13%. However, in the remaining 35% of the time, when the index scores a positive monthly close, the average monthly return is -10%. As we stand, the EGX30 is now trading at 2022e P/E of c.7x, which implies an earnings yield of c.15%.

Egypt's first blank-check company will be established within the next month, Financial Regulatory Authority (FRA) said. (<u>Bloomberg Asharq</u>)

Minister of Finance and Japan's ambassador in Cairo discussed potentially issuing foreign currency bonds in Japan as part of Egypt's debt diversification strategy. (Enterprise)

Egypt borrowed USD10.3bn from bilateral and multilateral lenders in 2021, according to the Ministry of International Cooperation's annual report. (Enterprise)

Rameda [RMDA] announced that it has begun the commercial production of Molupiravir Rameda, the generic form of the oral antiviral medicine developed by Merck and approved for the treatment of COVID-19 in adults, after receiving the necessary authorizations from the Egyptian Drug Authority (EDA). Abu Dhabi Islamic Bank - Egypt [ADIB] has applied to raise its authorized capital from EGP4bn to EGP7bn. (Mubasher)

The FRA predicts that trading on Nahr Al-Khair for Agricultural Investment & Environmental Services' [KRDI news] shares will commence this week. KRDI has a paid-in capital of EGP200mn distributed over 2bn shares at a par value of EGP0.1/share. (Mubasher)

GLOBAL NEWS

Oil prices rose more than USD1 on Tuesday to a more than seven-year high on worries about possible supply disruptions after Yemen's Houthi group attacked the United Arab Emirates. (Reuters)

The yen stumbled on Tuesday as U.S. Treasury yields rose to new near two-year highs and the Bank of Japan stressed its resolve to maintain ultra-loose monetary policy. (Reuters)


