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## Markets' Penumbra

## 1. Today's Trading Playbook

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## **KEY THEMES**

U.S. equities ended a choppy session yesterday nearly flat, as investors went in anticipation mode for an expected rate hike at the Federal Reserve meeting this week, as well as more earnings announcements to digest. Moreover, European index futures were pointing to a lower opening, pressured by disappointing earnings from **UBS**. On the other hand, oil prices rose on Tuesday on worries about tightening supply after Russia cut gas supply through a major pipeline to Europe.

Elsewhere, on a conference call held yesterday, Commercial International Bank - Egypt's [**COMI**] management indicated the following:

- (1) sluggish deposits are a result of the high-yield 18% p.a., which dented growth in Q2 2022; however, growth resumed strongly last month,
- (2) The 14% p.a. CDs offered by COMI should not hurt NIM too much, given high-yield Treasuries which will produce a reasonable spread. Management opted to provide funding sources at current rates, as another rate hike by the CBE is on the cards by the end of the year,
- (3) The sale of Treasuries that took place in Q1 2022 was meant to provide enough room for loan growth, given sluggish deposits growth, and ...
- (4) Management is targeting a loan book growth of c.30% for 2022, with the bottom line expected to register between EGP15-15.5bn.

## 2. TOP NEWS & ANALYSIS

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## **MACRO NEWS**

Egyptian Prime Minister's economic adviser said that in a TV interview that technical talks are ongoing with the IMF regarding a funding facility, but the two sides have different perspectives. She denied that there was any conflict in the talks. (Enterprise)

Egypt, Jordan, the UAE, and now Bahrain, have identified USD3.4bn worth of joint investment projects in the first phase of a USD10bn industrial partnership signed in May.

The agreements will see 12 projects in the food, agriculture, pharmaceuticals, and fertilizers sectors. The next stage of the partnership will focus on the metals, chemicals, plastics, and textiles industries. (Enterprise)

#### **CORPORATE NEWS**

Taaleem Management Services [TALM] and Siemens Healthineers collaborated to provide the hospitals at Taaleem's universities with the most recent medical technology solutions.

The partnership will see Siemens Healthineers imaging and laboratory equipment installed in NUB's university hospital, which is scheduled to open its doors in September 2022. (Company disclosure)

Shareholders of Abu Dhabi Islamic Bank [ADIB] have subscribed to 96% of the bank's EGP2bn capital increase at a par value of EGP10/share. (Company disclosure)

Shareholders of Dice Sport & Casual Wear [DSCW] have subscribed to 94.8% of DSCW's EGP265mn capital increase at a par value of EGP0.20/share. (Company disclosure)

Reportedly, Orascom Financial Holding [OFH] agreed to sell a 56% stake in Beltone Financial Holding [BTFH] at the EGP1.485/share offered by Chimera Investments. (Hapi)


